COMBAT MEDIC TRAINING THROUGH IMMERSIVE TECHNOLOGY

A recognized leader in military medical training, ECS has been developing the U.S. Army's Tactical Combat Casualty Care Simulation (TC3Sim) for over 17 years, continually investing in new and developing technologies. TC3Sim is a serious-game that focuses on training the critical skills for triage and treatment of trauma injuries and the top preventable causes of death on the battlefield. Military medical educators, combat medics, combat lifesavers, military service members, reservists, as well other medical first responders can benefit from this as a supplement to their initial or refresher training, and for providing just-in-time training to deploying service members.

ECS delivered this updated cross-platform application to support the existing training curriculum within the Army. This latest upgrade has transitioned to the U.S. Army Program Executive Office for Simulation, Training, and Instrumentation (PEO STRI) and continues to serve as a high-TRL platform for continued applied research and development for military use cases.

TC3Sim is published on the Google Play and the Apple App Store for use by United States (U.S.) military service members.
